Minimum Graduation Requirements

1. GPA in (a) all college course work, (b) Professional Education, and (c) area of specialization (major)..... 2.75
2. In courses in English, Communication, Social Studies, Science, Major Support Courses, Professional Education, and area of specialization "C"
3. GPA for Admission to Teacher Education..... 2.75
4. Proficiency in foreign language Novice 4 level

Students must meet all bachelor degree requirements at UCO to include:

- 40 hours of upper division coursework
- 30 hours in residence at UCO
- 15 of the last 30 hours must be taken in residence at UCO
