### Minimum Grade Requirements

1. Average in (a) all college course work, (b) course work at UCO ..... 2.50
2. Average in the major ..... 3.00
3. A grade of “C” or better must be earned in all courses in the major.

Students must meet all bachelor degree requirements at UCO to include:

- 60 hours from a baccalaureate granting institution
- 40 hours of upper division coursework
- 30 hours in residence at UCO
- 15 of the last 30 hours must be taken in residence at UCO
