1. Overall GPA in all college course work ..... 2.50
2. Average in course work at UCO ..... 2.00
3. Courses in English Composition, Fundamentals of Speech, Professional Education, and area of specialization (major)...“C”
4. Proficiency in foreign language ..... Novice 4 level

Students must meet all bachelor degree requirements at UCO to include minimums of:  
 40 hours of upper division coursework  
 30 hours in residence at UCO  
 15 of the last 30 hours must be taken in residence at UCO  
 60 hours from baccalaureate granting institutions
