Minimum Grade Requirements

1. Average in (a) all college course work, and (b) course work at UCO.....2.00
2. A minimum grade of "C" must be earned in all courses of the major to count toward meeting degree requirements.

Students must meet all bachelor degree requirements at UCO to include minimums of:

40 hours of upper division coursework

30 hours in residence at UCO

15 of the last 30 hours must be taken in residence at UCO

60 hours from baccalaureate granting institutions
